

Installing Progress Corticon Studio for Evaluation

To install Corticon Studio on your local Windows computer, you must obtain the Corticon Studio installer executable which you can download as a free trial version by visiting <https://www.progress.com/products/corticon>, and then clicking **Try Now**.

Follow these steps to install Corticon Studio for Evaluation:

1. Double-click the installer executable file to launch the installer wizard.
The installer opens in the installer wizard.
2. The first installer panel opens with information about the installer.
Click **Next** to continue.
3. The **License Agreement** panel opens. This panel displays the Progress Software End User License Agreement (EULA). Use the scroll bar at the right of the screen to read the agreement content. When you understand and agree to the terms, choose **I accept the terms in the license agreement**.
Click **Next** to continue.
4. The **Progress Corticon Studio Install and Work directory** panel opens. Specify the installation location. The default installation directory and the work directory are typically accepted.
Click **Next** to continue.
5. Leaving the default selection at **No** lets a typical evaluation installation proceed.
Click **Next** to continue.
6. The **Pre-installation Summary** panel opens. Confirm that your installation location has adequate disk space for the Corticon Studio components as well as at least 100 MB of workspace.
Click **Install** to continue.
An installation status window opens to display the state of the installation process.
When the process has finished, the **Install Complete** panel opens.
7. Click **Done** to quit and close the installer.

The installation of Corticon Studio is complete.

To open the Studio, choose the **Start** command **Progress > Corticon 6.x Studio**.

Note: Corticon embeds a timed evaluation license in each instance of Corticon Studio that lets you evaluate Corticon Studio features. If you see a License Warning alert when you attempt to start Corticon Studio, contact Progress Software Technical Support or a Progress sales representative for assistance.
